Runway centreline point - designator

Summary

In order to model the designator associated with a position along the runway centreline, it is proposed to add a new attribute in the RunwayCentrelinePoint.

Background

The [RunwayCentrelinePoint](#) class models operational points on the runway, such as threshold, start of run, etc.

Rationale for the change

Some centreline points are identified by a designator. For example, there are situations where the declared distances are specified for a point along the runway centreline, which is labelled "Point A", " Point V", etc. An example is EFHK airport in Finland. As this is not supported by the current model, it is proposed to add a "designator" property in the RunwayCentrelinePoint.

Change proposal details

In the RunwayCentrelinePoint class

- add a new attribute "designator"
 - definition = " A code or name by which the point is identified locally at the airport."
 - data type = TextDesignatorType
