



Background: Web Services for NextGen


- 4+ years of collaboration between NWS and FAA to make NextGen a reality
- Many partners, including NCAR, MIT/LL, NOAA/ESRL, MDL, AWC, AFWA, and FAA Hughes Tech. Ctr.
- Current effort has a clear path to operations between NWS and FAA

Web Services, Old and New

- WCS, WMS Reference Implementation by NCAR
 - Implemented at FAA Tech Center, NCAR, LL/MIT, NOAA/ESRL, AWC and MDL
- WFS Reference Implementation by MIT/LL
 - Implemented at FAA Tech Center, NCAR, LL/MIT, NOAA/ESRL, AWC and MDL
- EbXML Registry/Repository by Wellfleet
 - o Implemented at FAA Tech Center, LL/MIT, GSD, and MDL
- WCS, WMS, WFS prototype by ITT/Excellis
 - Implemented and being evaluated at MDL

Migrating Legacy Products

Input for FAA's Common Support Services---Weather (CSS-Wx)

- ~1000 grids (model, satellite)
- ~130 images
- METAR, SPECI, TAF, SIGMET
- Other Traditional Alphanumeric Codes (TAC). A small number, but many headaches
 - Requires considerable xml schema extension and development

Goals for TAC Schemas

- Logical organization of schemas on http: //www.weather.gov/ schemas
- Logical connections to METCE and IWXXM
 - Use of common constructs
 - Use of quantity attribute with references to repository at codes.wmo.int
 - Use of vocabulary attribute with references to code lists at WMO and NWS sites

Center Weather Advisory (CWA)

• Contents similar to NWS Convective SIGMETs. Different criteria.

Meteorological Impact Statement (MIS)

- Valid times
- Generally valid for entire airspace
- Free text with only general guidelines

Select Products and Notes

Area Forecast (FA)

- Coded, Traditional Alphanumeric Product
- Valid times
- Valid for large portions of airspace, divided by state, state fractions, and major bodies of water
- Sections of text, generally focusing on clouds, visibility, and weather

Sample Area Forecast

Implementation Strategy

- Create schemas, most important first, for aviation-based Traditional Alphanumeric Code (TAC) products
- If needed, develop software that can decode TAC and encode XML
- Upgrade product generation software to create TAC and XML simulatneously
